

Open Access Youth Provision

LinacreOne and Breathe+ have received funding to work in partnership and deliver youth provision in the Litherland/Ford area from Sefton Council Neighbourhood Regeneration department.

The youth provision will be offered to all young people living within these boundaries and everyone that wants to join in will be able to take part, subject to available places on each activity.

The activities we have to offer include:

- Street Cage Soccer - This will be offered to males and females aged between 8-13 years old and 14 to 16 year olds. The project will start on 27th July 2006, Thursday's 2pm-4pm at Mellanear Park.
- City Culture – This project will be delivered by Groundwork Trust and involves a 10 week programme looking at culture, social living, history, jobs, education and raising young peoples' aspirations. The young people taking part in this activity will get the opportunity to take part in a three day visit to Dublin, Glasgow and Liverpool. Recruitment will begin in July by the Sefton Connexions Team.
- 408 Youth Project – There will be many activities on offer which will revolve around confidence building, an assertiveness programme, raising self awareness and developing people's transferable skills. Monday evenings between 4pm – 7pm, at the 408 Youth Project. The start date for this will be confirmed shortly.
- Litherland 2100 – Will be delivered by Acme Arts and involves researching Litherland's history over the last 100 years. This material will be the basis for creating an animation.
- Saturday Morning Club – Litherland Youth centre will be extending their opening times so that it is available for use on Saturday mornings from 10.00am to 12.30pm for forty-six weeks. Ages of 10 to 13 years old.
